

1 "Section 3. _____. Compilation of Laws

2 The General Assembly shall provide by law for
3 the establishment of a uniform system of compilation of
4 any statute, resolution, rule, regulation, ordinance, order,
5 proclamation, or any other action by any unit of government
6 having the force of law and for their publication. Unless
7 otherwise provided by law, no action having the force of
8 law shall be effective until it shall have been made a part
9 of such compilation and published."

17 involves something that is omitted in the present Constitution
18 and it will become of greater importance in the future
