

1 part of the Constitution a provision that was absolutely
2 meaningless, his conflict of laws provision. It seems to
3 me that this is an excellent provision. It means something.
4 It will give poeple notice of the laws and I think it will be
5 very helpful to all people in the enforcement of the laws.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Lord.

7 DELEGATE LORD: Mr. Chairman, the troublesome
8 aspect of this amendment as I see it is the second sentence.
9 I am very much in sympathy with the principal and agree with
10 Delegate Willoner and Delegate Grant. As I read the second
11 sentence, among the objections mentioned by Judge Henderson
12 was the delay in compilation.

13 I think another valid objection is that it seems
14 to me it puts the General Assembly in the position of
15 obstructing acts that local subdivisions have sought in there
16 wisdom to make effective immediately, and I suggest this
17 could be tampered with and puts the General Assembly in the
18 catbird's seat and unless the second sentence were struck,
19 I would have to oppose it.
