4 General Assembly would provide by rule those things which
5 are called for in 3.17 (A).

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Are there any questions of the
7 sponsor of the amendment? Delegate Macdonald.

8 DELEGATE MACDONALD: I just have an observation.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Make the observation.

10 DELEGATE MACDONALD: In the Article on the
11 Judicial Branch we use the term "by rule" probably as a
12 term apart, and the court refers to a rule by the Court of
13 Appeals. Here we use the same term, and we obviously do not
14 mean the same thing. We can just call it to the attention
15 to the Committee on Style.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gallagher.

17 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: I believe it is a word of
18 art insofar as the General Assembly is concerned because
19 both the house and senate does offer its own rules and it is
20 guided by them, so it has a distinct meaning when you are
21 dealing with matters pertaining to a legislative branch.
