

1 to file a Minority Report if they want a Minority
2 Report to come to the Convention.

3 Secondly, Rule 27 of the Rules as they now
4 stand guarantees any delegate an opportunity for hearing
5 by a committee, if the committee reports to take action with
6 respect to substantive matter covered by his proposal.
7 Certainly, a minority feeling will have already been
8 represented by a proposal introduced in the Convention; so
9 there is at least one day there. Then Rule 31 provides
10 there has to be a three day delay, and I would imagine
11 when
12 that/this Convention reaches the full press of business
13 that it will be more than a three day delay before a
14 report reaches the Committee of the Whole and is taken up
15 in the Committee of the Rule.

16 Next, Rule 28 guarantees that a report of at
17 least 20 per cent of a committee, quote, Shall be re-
18 ceived, printed in the same manner as the Majority Report,
19 and treated as an amendment or substitute offered to or
20 for the report of the committee, if offered as such on
21 the floor, end quote.
