

1 DELEGATE JOHNSON: So that, Mr. Chairman, if  
2 the Minority was not ready to report within three days, the  
3 Convention may not receive the Minority Report unless  
4 the majority of the Convention agreed to hear it? Should  
5 I repeat it?

6 THE PRESIDENT: Please.

7 DELEGATE JOHNSON: The question to the Chairman,  
8 Mr. President was, isn't it a fact that under the general  
9 order for the day that a Minority Report may not be  
10 received if it isn't received within the three days,  
11 unless by action of a majority of the Convention, so that  
12 it is possible, just possible, under the existing rules,  
13 that the Convention would have only the Majority Report  
14 to consider?

15 DELEGATE SCANLAN: It is possible under any set  
16 of rules that if a minority didn't act when the time  
17 permitted, the Convention would not be in a position to  
18 consider its report at the same time. The present rules  
19 giving specifically Rule 31 a three day delay and the point  
20 I made earlier, at least one more day between the time  
21 the Majority Report reaches the Committee of the Whole
