

1 be exempt from taxation in the same manner and to the same  
2 extent as agencies of State and local governments as to  
3 their income derived from furnishing public services and  
4 as to their property, both real and personal, used and use-  
5 ful in supplying such services to the public, provided  
6 that as to all other property and income, such public  
7 service companies and co-operatives shall be taxed in the  
8 same manner and to the same extent as other privately  
9 owned business ventures are taxed by State and local govern-  
10 ments.
