

1 MR. QUILLEN: Delegate Proposal No. 306, by
2 Delegate Finch, A proposal that the Constitution provide
3 that new apportionment standards shall require election
4 districts to be substantially equal in total population,
5 as determined by the Federal decennial census; that the
6 election districts shall be contiguous and compact; and
7 that, wherever practicable, pre-existing political sub-
8 division boundaries and natural geographical boundaries
9 shall be used as district boundaries. Gerrymandering for
10 any purpose is prohibited.

11 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Proposal No. 306 is

15 MR. QUILLEN: Delegate Proposal No. 307, by
16 Delegate Finch, A proposal that the Constitution provide
17 that a judge who has reached the mandatory retirement
18 age shall be permitted to continue to hold office if he is
19 certified as being mentally and physically competent.
