14 Delegate Finch, A proposal that the Constitution provide that
15 Amendments to this Constitution may be proposed either by
16 the affirmative vote of three-fifths of all the members
17 of each house of the General Assembly of two successively
18 elected Legislatures, or by a majority of all the members
19 of a Constitutional Convention called by the General Assem-
20 bly. In either case, the proposed amendment shall be sub-
21 mitted to the voters of the State at a special or General
