5 One other thing needed to complete the directory
6 is, gain your cooperation. Many of you have indicated,
7 since we first asked for the completed address list, a
8 desire to change the preferred address on the directory.
9 Will each of you please check the address you have given
10 as your preferred address and home number, et cetera,
11 and if you want to change it, will you dictate a memoran-
12 dum of the change to one of the secretaries in the office
13 of the Secretary of the Convention, a change of home
14 address, change of Annapolis address, telephone number,
15 any other information will enable the delegates to reach
16 you when you are not right here. I would greatly appre-
17 ciate it if you would each make it a point to do this,
18 certainly by the end of tomorrow; and we will assume that
19 if we don't hear from any of you or any we don't hear
20 from, we will assume the information that is already
21 available is complete and correct.
