3 DELEGATE MITCHELL: I simply, Mr. Chairman,  
4 I would like to be corrected, but I would like to state  
5 for the purpose of the record of this historic Convention  
6 that I must disagree with the description of the Federal  
7 Government, which our distinguished Chairman and President  
8 of the Convention gave in his opening address yesterday  
9 afternoon. It is my hope that this Convention will not  
10 be a sounding board for anti-<sup>federalism</sup>~~paternalism~~. I believe that  
11 we are one nation. I believe that the demands of the  
12 times are so great ~~that~~ teamwork among the officials  
13 of the Federal and State Governments is essential to our  
14 survival; and I hope I am wrong, but it seemed to me that  
15 our President was declaring war on the Federal Government,  
16 which in reality would be declaring war on ourselves.

17 I believe that we must face the fact that  
18 there are some problems of this State, and the rest of the  
19 States of this Union, such as the protection of human  
20 rights, the building of highways, the conservation of our
