

1 in its decision in 1908 in the Gains Case from the Uni-
2 versity of Missouri Law School by opening the University
3 of Maryland Law School to all citizens and to quali-
4 fying Negro citizens who did not have an opportunity,
5 for opportunity in the law in state facilities.

6 This state in 1938 invalidated the state legis-
7 lature's dual standards of teacher pay when Negroes in the
8 state, in the law of the state, could only receive half
9 that of white teachers, and coming on up the state, through
10 its courts and the leadership of men of good will, set
11 the precedent for the nation.

12 We believe that we can achieve the ideals of
13 our founding fathers which have sounded around the world
14 that we need not resort to force but to the rule of law in
15 achieving dignity and justice and equality of all men and
16 we believe that in this recommended language of the
17 minority report we can again give that leadership to this
18 state and this nation in these perilous times.
