

1 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Hostetter.

2 DELEGATE HOSTETTER: At the conclusion of your
3 minority report, Delegate Mitchell, you set forth a
4 basic policy wherein you list a number of items.

5 One of the items listed is licensees. A point
6 of clarification. Are lawyers considered as licensees
7 and as such operating under the aegis or authority of
8 the state?

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Mitchell.

10 DELEGATE MITCHELL: There has not been a case
11 brought to the Supreme Court in that area, Delegate Hos-
12 tetter, and I would say that with the Supreme Court in
13 the cases where it has interpreted what is state action,
14 that the determination of what is state action evolved upon
15 the circumstances of each case, but I am sure members of
16 the general public who would want a lawyer's services
17 wouldn't go to a lawyer who didn't want to represent
18 them.

20 DELEGATE HOSTETTER: Would a corporate charter
21 fall within the scope of this amendment of the minority?
