3 DELEGATE WILLONER: In light of your answer to
4 Mr. Gleason's question, wouldn't it be better then to
5 use the lower case, "s", for state, or was your intent to
6 use it?

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Mitchell.

8 DELEGATE MITCHELL: No, I think I am not aware
9 of how -- it was not our intention to capitalize it, or
10 we did not type it up, but the word itself is self-
11 explanatory, I think, in itself.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Willoner, the Chair
13 might observe that if we follow the rules, which I think
14 are being followed by the Committee on Style, you would use
15 lower case only if you used it as an adjective.
