

1 to discrimination by the state because of race, color,
2 religion, or national origin."

3 I submit not even the proponents know the
4 meaning of these words, and yet you and I are asked to
5 submit them into our Constitution.

6 In fact, what does due process mean? The
7 Courts for years have been trying to determine this. In
8 Baltimore City we had a ruling by the Liquor Board, not
9 even a judge, that would allow Negroes to enter taverns.

10 This is not even a judge, and yet this was his
11 interpretation. The minority suggests that this is a
12 mandate to the courts. We had a court decision today by
13 the Supreme Court that said, Communists could now work in
14 defense industry, which just proves that nine old men
15 are still running our country.

16 If we adopted the minority's wording we could
17 get a very narrow determination by a conservative
18 judge, and a more liberal understanding from a liberal
19 judge.

20 May I caution you by saying that no positive
21 determination on our part will have a more wider
