4 The law is there. It is not going to change.
5 If a court wants to make a determination, there is plenty
6 of language available to it but what I read to you there
7 was the 14th Amendment, Section 1, United States Consti-
8 tution.

9 Now, this is the law of the land. I suggest
10 to you that the minority amendment does not appreciably
11 broaden what I have just read to you, but merely spells
12 it out for we in the State of Maryland.
