5 delegates, when I first rose I rose because I was very
6 confused by Delegate Hardwicke.

7 I couldn't understand how his name could be
8 on the minority report and then he lead the opposition to
9 that report, especially when I considered him a fair-
10 minded man, who either stood for something or didn't
11 stand for it.

12 After that time passed, and a lot of delegates
13 expressed the opinion that they couldn't understand why
14 this would be necessary to put in the Constitution. There
15 is one reason why we can't understand. You have never been
16 a Negro. Perhaps you will never understand for that
17 basic reason, but if we had nine white people down here and
18 the rest of them colored instead of the reverse,
19 nine colored and the rest of you white, all of the rest
20 of those delegates would understand that this would be a
21 vital inclusion in the Constitution, not because we want
