2 these words in the Constitution was a tremendous one and
3 an important one, and had been recognized by the Consti-
4 tutional Commission.

5 I am afraid that we have been a little restricted
6 by adopting that amendment, and I voted for it even so,
7 but now, since we have been, I think, a little restricted,
8 I would like to broaden the language and include "sex".

9 I think sex was included as a non-discriminatory
10 feature under the original committee proposal, and I ask
11 all of you who voted with me on Amendment 3 to please
12 vote with me on this one the same way.

13 I think we have been a little restricted. We
14 did so to provide the psychological advantage. Let's keep
15 sex in there, or put it in.
