9 Nevertheless, I have to, on the face of it,
10 say that what women we have talked to, and we have really
11 talked to them, and found out that what they are about
12 to get if we eliminate all of the protections that they
13 sometimes have now, they might not otherwise have, some-
14 times they find themselves like bulldogs chasing the auto-
15 mobile.

16 I urge you to vote against this.
