2 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Storm.

3 DELEGATE STORM: Mr. Chairman, I am perfectly
4 willing to postpone action, if someone wants to bring
5 in information to show that the original committee report
6 was very negligent in this respect, but I had faith
7 in that report, that no person meant no person, regard-
8 less, and there would be no harmful effects from it.

9 Now, I feel a little bit confused, and I am
10 really glad I voted for that non-discriminatory clause,
11 because evidently things weren't as I kind of understood
12 them.

13 Now, if you want to postpone it and if that is
14 in order I am perfectly willing to wait, and have
15 some authorities brought in.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Storm, the Chair
17 suggests that the confusion arises because there is a
18 difference between the language "no person shall be denied
19 equal protection of laws because of sex" and the language
20 "no person shall be discriminated against because of sex".
