16 THE CHAIRMAN: Strike the language beginning  
17 with the semicolon?

18 DELEGATE L. TAYLOR: Yes.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: The rest of that line, all of  
20 line 9 and all of line 10 except the period?

21 DELEGATE L. TAYLOR: Yes, and I would like to
