

1 wondering whether it is possible for these amendments to be
2 withdrawn with prejudice so that we don't have to sit
3 here and anticipate that they will be coming back again,
4 because I think it is unfair to the Committee to listen
5 to the debate and to get to the point where they want to
6 vote and then to have an amendment withdrawn, to perhaps
7 be submitted when we are in a better mood.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: Under the explicit provisions of
9 Rule 44, an amendment may be withdrawn by the maker at any
10 time before it is put to vote. There is no procedure by
11 which it can be withdrawn only with prejudice.

12 Any other delegate can offer the amendment and
13 put it to vote if he chooses to do so.

14 I might point out that I believe there have been
15 very, very few cases in which an amendment withdrawn has
16 been resubmitted.

17 Are you ready for the question on Amendment 6?
18 Do all delegates have a copy?

19 The question arises on the adoption of Amend-
20 ment No. 6. A vote Aye is a vote in favor of the amend-
21 ment. A vote No is a vote against.
