3 Now, if a person were aggrieved by an action of
4 an administrative body which they felt denied them due
5 process, there is a procedure for appeals to courts, and
6 the matter would get to courts. But very definitely due
7 process would apply to all. This would apply to admini-
8 strative procedures as well as court procedures.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Grant.

10 DELEGATE GRANT: In view of the amendment which
11 we made which added the word "religion to the section,"
12 and in view of the fact that we turned down a further
13 amendment to change that to "free," do you interpret the
14 word "revision" to apply to situations like the Schow-
15 gurow case or the Mappe case?

16 DELEGATE KIEFER: Yes. Specifically in cases
17 like Schowgurow, that was the case where a person had been
18 indicted by a grand jury and he was a member of
19 I believe the Hindu faith, and because the jury was sworn
20 with respect to a belief in God, he felt that he was dis-
21 criminated against.
