3 DELEGATE WEIDEMEYER: I think it is not germane
4 to the subject.

5 DELEGATE CLARK: The Chair recognizes Delegate
6 Willoner.

7 DELEGATE WILLONER: Delegate Weidemeyer, the
8 limitation period of three years is not to apply to the
9 completion of court trials but only to the filing of the
10 condemnation papers?

11 DELEGATE WEIDEMEYER: That is it. Once the court
12 suit is instituted, it is reasonably inferred that they
13 have a right to complete it.

14 DELEGATE CLARK: The Chair recognizes Delegate
15 Gilchrist.

16 DELEGATE GILCHRIST: Would you mind saying what
17 you mean by damaging?
