

1 We are still experimenting with the multilith
2 arrangement, and we find that it poses quite a problem
3 to have the proposals multilithed in the interval between
4 noon and the meeting of the Convention at 2:00 p.m.
5 As is usually the case, most of the proposals come in
6 shortly before noon. We will be able, however, to do this
7 with an additional piece of equipment and a little more
8 manpower. Today we are not able to have on your desks,
9 or have delivered to you, copies of every proposal
10 that will be introduced this afternoon. They may come
11 over during the session. If not, they will be sent to
12 you very promptly.

14 yesterday that the additional binder that was placed on your
15 desk in the chamber was for your use in keeping copies
