5 I understood it, to say that the General Assembly could
6 enact legislation that may take away this particular
7 right to reform or organize.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Bothe.

9 DELEGATE BOTHE: I believe I did so that.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Nielson.

11 DELEGATE NIELSON: My question is this: Could
12 the legislature take away -- strike that.

13 Isn't there a reservation in Item 10, Section
14 10 of this same article that we are discussing that would
15 preserve this right?

16 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Nielson, if you will
17 permit the Chair to ask you, you mean your question to
18 be directed to the situation that exists if this amend-
19 ment were not made?
