*A PROPOSAL that the effective date of a law enacted by the General Assembly, with certain exceptions, shall not be sooner than sixty days after its enactment, and that the effective date of a law properly petitioned to referendum within the said sixty-day period shall not be sooner than thirty days after its approval at referendum, unless said law was passed by the affirmative vote of three-fifths of all the members of each house of the General Assembly.*
