THE CHAIRMAN: The question arises on the approval of Committee Recommendation R&P-2, as amended, with the exception of sections 10, 11, and 13.

Delegate Mentzer.

DELEGATE MENTZER: Would you please tell me what happened to section 6.

THE CHAIRMAN: Section 6 was deleted, with the understanding that the same subject matter is contained in Committee Recommendation GP-9.

Are you ready for the question?

(Call for the question.)

The question arises on the approval of Committee Recommendation R&P-2, as amended, with the exception of sections 10, 11, and 13, which will not be acted upon.

A vote Aye is a vote in favor of Committee Recommendation R&P-2 as amended, except for those three sections. A vote No is a vote against. Cast your vote.

Has every delegate voted? Does any delegate desire to change his vote?

(There was no response.)

The Clerk will record the vote.

There being 107 votes in the affirmative and 17 in the negative, the motion carries. Committee Recommendation R&P-2, except for sections 10, 11, and 13, is adopted, as amended.

The Chair recognizes Delegate Powers.

DELEGATE POWERS: Mr. Chairman, I move the Committee of the Whole rise and report to the Convention its approval of Committee Recommendation R&P-2, with the exceptions of sections 10, 11, and 13.

THE CHAIRMAN: Second?

(Whereupon, the motion was duly seconded.)

THE CHAIRMAN: All those in favor, signify by saying Aye; contrary, No. The

Ayes have it. It is so ordered.

(Whereupon, at 1:10 P.M., the Committee of the Whole rose, and the Convention reconvened.)
