

the Sheriff impanelled a Grand Jury of sixteen men.





Know all men by these presents that Henry Bishop Esq^r of the County of Somerset in the County
do acknowledge my self to owe and stand justly indebted unto John Williams Esq^r of the above sd County
Somerset in the full and just sum of and quantity of five thousand five hundred pounds of good sound money
to be paid Conventionally on Cotcombe River according to Act of Assembly betwixt the day of the date
of these presents and the tenth day of November next ensuing, the whole payment well and truly to be made & paid
to my Heirs, Executors, Assigns firmly by these presents to the sd John Williams Esq^r, his Heirs, Executors, Assigns
without fraud or Error. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 14th day of Sept^r. Anno Domini 1685.


