


To all Christian People to whom this deed of gift shall or may come that I Edward: Hammond of the County of Bury
 and Province of Maryland sundry greeting yr. Know ye that I the said Edward: Hammond, for the good will satisfaction
 that I bear unto Samuel: Howell of the said County do give, grant bestow and confirm, and by virtue
 of this present deed of gift, freely really absolutely and irrevocably, give bestow and confirm unto Samuel: Howell
 as above, three Cows, to wit one Cow of five year old, and two Cows of three year old, and one steer of two year old, and
 one yearling Heifer, all these Cows having each of them a calf by their side, marked viz. the left ear being Ceph and
 under bills and over bills and a slit in the right ear, all which Cattle as above mentioned, I give grant and bestow upon
 Samuel: Howell as above with their future increase for male unto him his Heirs or Assigns for ever, and all the male increase
 that now is or shall accrue by the said Cows I give grant and bestow unto Samuel: Howell as above his Heirs or Assigns for ever
 and will with my hand and seal this thirteenth day of June Anno Domini 1690.



To all people to whom this writing shall come greeting. Know ye that John Burdland of Somersett County in y^e Province
 of Maryland Widow, as well for the satisfaction of the request and desire of my loving husband Richard Burdland lately
 deceased, and for other considerations unto him unto moving, have given, and by this presents do give unto my son Richard
 Burdland Son of the aforesaid Richard Burdland deceased one Cow with a red Cow calf being marked with a Ceph
 or slit in the left ear and a hole in the right ear with the female increase of the same to him and his Heirs and Assigns
 for ever to be marked from him to him with the aforesaid mark, being the mark of the said Richard Burdland deceased
 also I have given and by this presents do give unto my son Richard: Burdland a furred Cow pelt leather stamped
 within side the bottom with R B: and also one Iron pot for the use and behoof of the said Richard his Heirs or Assigns
 likewise if the said Richard Burdland my son do live until he shall be eighteen years of age he is to be free for
 to act for him self according to the request and desire of his father deceased, In testimony to the truth above written
 I the said John: Burdland have hereunto set my hand and seal this seventh day of June Anno Domini 1690

Maryland. Know all men by these presents that I Thomas: Miller of Potomack in the County of Somerset do
 hereby acknowledge my self, my Heirs, Executors, Adors or Assigns, to stand justly indebted unto Thomas:
 Howbold of the same County his Heirs and Assigns, in the full and just quantity of forty and two large Culls
 of good sufficient five foot and half long, & eight inches wide of Cypress timber, saye quarter to make
 some good boards of three quarters of inch thick, to be delivered at Hodges quarter Landing, att or upon y^e
 15th of feby next ensuing, being for one ke of fire, and one barrel of Quince drinks w^{ch} of the said
 Howbold for the said timber, and likewise the said Miller is to returne the said ke and barrel when supply to the
 said Howbold at his Landing, and the said Thomas: Miller do hereby engage to assist the said Howbold to make a
 draft to get it to his Landing, but if the said Miller do not forthwith send the Culls when they are supply
 then the said Miller is to pay the said Howbold five Culls of timber as above expressed for the said Culls in witness
 hereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 31st of January, 1687.
