Assignes as Master to the sd Robert is to teach or cause to be taught him the trade or occupation of a Cooper
in the best manner whiche to the sd John doth or shall practice during the sd time, and is to furnish
wite sufficient meat, drink, washing, and lodging, shoes and hose, clothes of woollen and linnen during
the time aforesd, and is at the expiration of his time to give him a Cow of three years old, and a sett of Cooper
tools, and a saw and pigg in wittness whereof both parties have hereunto sett their hands and seals interchangably
the 24. day of February and year above written.
