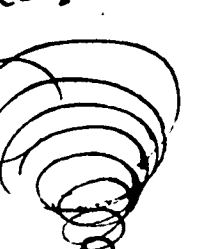
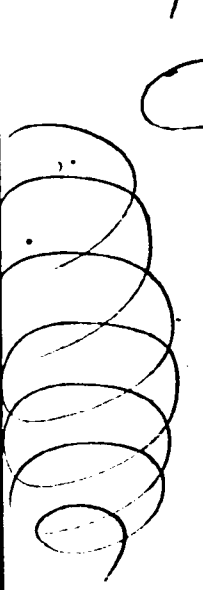

I know all men by these presents that we Walter: Mathew and Gray: Kiffin both of Somerset County do: acknowledge and confess our selves to owe and are indebted unto Cap: William: Culbourn of the aforesd County the just sum of Seven hundred pounds of good sound merchantable tobacco in Cash which was promised to pay to the sd Culbourn or his Heirs, Executors, Adors or Assigns, for the which payment we bind us our Heirs or Assigns in the full sum of Three thousand four hundred pounds of tobacco. In testimony whereof we bind us our Heirs Executors Adors and Assigns — firmly by these presents. In testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and Seals this 20. day of November 1684.

The Court having considered the abuse and misdemeanors of the sd John: Taylor agt the sd Wm: and others, that they do: Order that John: Taylor plead no more at Barr. Order likewise that he give security for good behavior till next Court. And whereupon came Cap: William: Culbourn and M: Coler both with the sd Taylor, and did by recognizance confess themselves to be indebted unto their Ma: in the sum of five pounds sterling for part Taylor in ten pounds to be levied on their goods and shallers. The Condition of which recognizance is such that if the aforesd John Taylor be of the good behavior to all their Ma: Ldgs people of this County: that then this recognizance be void and of none effect, otherwise to remain in full power force and virtue.
