Somerset County sh. Joseph Freeman late of Somerset County / was summoned to answer unto Thomas Dixon of a Ba that he / render unto him One thousand nine hundred pounds of good sound / Merchants lobs and Cash, which he said to owe him unjustly / and wrongfully.

And whereupon the said Thomas by Peter his Attorney saith that the said Joseph the 25th day of / May in the year of our Lord at Moncton within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his return bill / obligatory which the said Thomas with the seal of the said Joseph signed bringeth unto this Court / the date whereof is the day and year aforesaid at New Bedford himself to be bound to the said Thomas / in the said just and full sum of One thousand nine hundred pounds of lobs and Cash to be paid to / the said Thomas upon demand at some port or place in the said County to the whole payment with / and truly to be made, the said Joseph bound himself firmly by the said Bill, however that the said Joseph / the said sum of 1900 pounds of lobs to the said Thomas although often demanded the same to / the said Thomas hath not rendered but hath utterly denied, and still doth deny to the damage of / the said Thomas of 2800 pounds of lobs and thereof he bringeth his suit or / Bill.
