to said Custalb and from him escaped where the said Selby did not only entertain, but after the Custalb  
was taken the said minor did popularly deny his affant, but did and defied and abrogated the present  
by his hate escaped and frustrated judgment and condigne punishment according to law, wherefore that the

from the said house, it being the 19. of this instant monte at night your deponent desired the said Selby to  
the said minor not to stand it out against authority for it would be worse for him or wife him so to do, un  
til the said Selby 6 hours for that night and the next morning repaired thither again to see what might be  
done in this present but all to no purpose, the said minor mad his estate towards Hammett this your deponent
