to and worthfull. which I promise to pay unto the abovesaid Michael: Hannay and Adam Spont
to have their Executors Heirs or Assignes, and for the true performanc of the same to be well
truly paid, I have in my Heirs, Executors, Heirs, Assignes, firmly by these presents, In testimony whereof
have hereunto sett my hand this 29th day of Sept. An. Dom. 1686.

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the abovesaid John: Osborn his Heirs Executors
Assignes, Heirs, shall and will well and truly make over and assigne all his right Interest &
title of two hundred Acres of Land already sold to the abovesaid Michael: Hannay and Adam
Spont, to them or to their Heirs, or Executors, according to forme and manner prescribed
by Act of Assembly then this Obligation to be void and of none effect otherways to be and
remain in full force and virtue.

seventy one perches, thence bounding upon a pt sold Joshua Light, North West half a point North
west hundred and fourteen perches, thence 38 ft by South, eighty three perches, thence by a straight
line South east three degrees Southwardly to the first bounded Red Oak where is laid out for one
hundred Acres be it more or less.
