 entered into Recognizance of 5th the said Edward in 10. to perform as above. The Condition
 is such that if the above bound Edward William, do make his personal appearance at
 next Court to be holden the second Wednesday in September next then he shall have to answer what
 is objected agt him by His Ma^{ty} Justice of the peace, and also to pay all fees due. And if
 he fail to do so, he shall be bound to remain in full force & value.

David: Maglathan being bound over to Court, made his appearance
 Cap. John: Under being bound for the said Maglathan's appearance and behavior
 is first to be dismissed from the said Bond which was granted, and further Ordered, that
 the said Maglathan give new Security for his good behavior & Court Charges. And
