Woodland as also his tormenting of their Ma^{ties} Authority together wth divers other misdemeanours as beating and abusing his sister in Law a Widow and imbezling of her Estate as by sundry proofs made out, some of which unlawfull acts were proved to be acted and done upon a Sabbath day or.

They are therefore to will and require of to returne this to George Howard and him scilicet George will be put in good and sufficient Sureties for his good behaviour or abstinence as also to answer to such matters as shall be objected agt him at the next Court to be holden for this County the second Tuesday of this next month as well in the behalfe of their Ma^{ties} as on the part of the Widow, And that at the said Court you have the said George Howard there together with this our warrant and hereof in their Ma^{ties} names you are not to fail as you will answer the Contempt at y^e peril y^e shall the day and year above sd

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound George Howard shall make his personall appearance at the next Court hold for this County being the second Tuesday of this present Instant August and there answer unto what shall be objected on the behalfs of their Ma^{ties} and the Widow agt him, as also in the mean time be of the good abstinence. Then this Obligation to be void and of none effect or otherwise to remaine in full strength and virtue.
