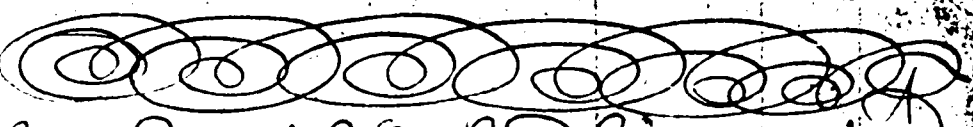


Coppie of Oate of Allegiance

by their Subjects, or any other person what so ever. And you do declare that no forreign Prince, Prelate
State or Colonies, hath or ought to have any Jurisdiction, Power, Superiority, Preeminence or
Authority, Ecclesiasticall or spiritual wite in that Realm. So help you God

Layfield Esq: One of their Ma^{ties} Justices of the Peace for this County was
bound over to answer their Ma^{ties} what should be objected by William Milner
of this County Esq: at a County Court hold the sth day in August

Their Ma^{ties} Attorney Esq: and says that the sd Sears and Fleetwood upon the sth day in June
last past at the dwelling house of the sd Milner, in the sd Milner's abutment, and in the night, the sd Milner's
house being into, the same did rife, and out of the window, did feloniously pilfer, steal and carry away, eight
gallons of Rum, one pair of blue linnen drawers, and one knife, not having any fear of God before their eyes
but wilfully waiting the opportunity of the sd Milner's abutment to rob and rife his house, steal and carry away
