Sigdall of the same County and Province of Maryland Chamber in the just sum or quantity of two thousand pounds of good sound Merchants to be paid to the said Wm. Sigdall his Heirs, Executors, Assigns or Assignes to the whole payment well and truly to be made and done, we bind our selves and either of us Our Heirs Executors Assigns and Assignes firmly by these presents, In witness whereof we have hereunto put our hands and seals this two and twentieth day of February Anno Domini 1687.

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bounden Thomas Hallon his Heirs Executors Assigns do on or before the first day of November next following the date hereof by an Indenture to be purposed well and sufficiently alienate lease and Confrim unto the above named Wm. Sigdall his Heirs Executors Assigns or Assignes One hundred acres of Land being a part of five hundred acres of Land lying in Hantscoke in Somerset County in the Province of Maryland, called Liverpools and near the River it being laid out and surveyed for the said Thomas Hallon and bounded as by the patent for the same, the said lands being had more fully and at large it doth and may appear, This said hundred acres of Land to begin at a marked Line being the boundary betwixt the said land of Cuddeys Johnson and the land of the said Thomas Hallon and so to run thence north west on the side of Hantscoke to the bridge of it, and five hundred thirty two paces and one third of a part up into the wood south east, and so proper half the other line. And the same hundred acres of Land to be discharged from all arrears of Rent mill that day and all other incumbrances then this Obligation to be void and of none effect, otherwise to stand remain and abide in full force power and virtue.
