I shall reward your petition in sume Part last moved your w^rs that if any Securitie given by
Somedam to Mr. Proffitt decaſt might take some providentars to prevent the above ſecuritie
from interzuing and waſhing the Orphant^s Estate by bartering and swapping and ſue^r like
Dealing^s whiche was daily practice. But ſince I cannot have of any Securitie given now this ſaid Recd
fearing he might be taken to me. For his true report in hui hate him. The Capl^t Earl abſent being
not being capable to do uſe out of the abord to Orphant^s Estate, Therefore yo^r Behalfe humbly prayd
that your w^rs will pleafe to grant that the care of the ſame, and what ſmall matter of ſame remains
upon Surry may be referred to your Behalfe being further in Law to the Orphant^s Behalfe
giving ſame ſecuritie as your w^rs ſhall admitt of. And your Behalfer as in duty bound ſhall
ever pray at leter.

The ſe^r Behalfe being Read and Considered by the Cur^t, whose Opinion and Order it is^r by
the above mentioned Orphant, do still remain and Continue with William Durville. the
ſaid Durville ſtanding ſecuritie according to Law in ſame ſays required.
