Court a witness in his behalf agt John. Swain, and your petitioners did stand upon this wor. Court these days, your Petitions ~~attended~~ humbly prayed yo worships Order of Court for yo petitioners charges, and your humble petitioners shall pray.

To the wor. their Majesties Justices of the peace for Somerset County the humble petition of Francis Sherrowood and William. White sheweth that there is a claim depending betwixt in Lawrence Crawford and your humble petitioners, caused to come to speedy tryall for these reasons following. first it is about a Cy press swamp belonging to the Children of John. White deceased and by the next Oath the sd Crawford may may. sell and dispose of all or most part of what timber is or may be in it, And your petitioners as in duty shall ever pray. Upon which petition being read in George Layfield promised the Court that the aforesaid two hundred Acres of Swamp, he would immediately cause to be surveyed and laid out, which till then, the Court thought that the said Crawford made no waste nor soil of any of the sd Timber thereto belonging.

Jonathan Towres Esq. agt. Lawrence. Crawford Esq. Somerset County st. Lawrence. Crawford of this County put was summoned to answer unto Jonathan. Towres of the same County Cooper in an action on the Case. And whereupon the ptt by Edward Jones his Attorney tendered and saith that in Edward. White late of this County deceased and possessor to the defendant did sell a certain plantation unto the ptt and at the expiration of six years the ptt did remove from the said plantation and left in two house upon the said plantation sixteen hoggsheads of lawfull of the ptt. And about the last of June or the 1 July in the year 1689. then the deft came to the aforesaid lawfull house, and then did take and put out of the aforesaid sixteen hoggsheads of lawfull belonging to the ptt to the great loss and damage of the ptt.
