The same day Ralph: Milbourne appeared in Court, being bound by Perogizant
 in September last to prosecute Jacob: Martin this Court, where y^e said Martin
 appeared, and being the same day prosecuted by the Grand Jury. The Court
 ordered that y^e said Martin, immediately give in security for his
 appearance the next Court to be held on the second Tuesday in January next.

Jacob: Martin, you do acknowledge to stand indebted to this Ma^{ty} 20 sh
 to be levied on your goods, Chables lands and Demourals.

John: Taylor, you do acknowledge to stand indebted to this Ma^{ty} 10 s
 to be levied on your goods Chables lands and Demourals.

Peter: Whaples you do acknowledge to stand indebted to this Ma^{ty} 7 s
 10 s shilling money to be levied on your goods Chables lands and Demourals.

The condition of the above said Perogizant is such that if the above
 bound Jacob: Martin, do make his personall appearance at the next Court
 Court to be holden the 2. Tuesday in January next then and there to answer
 to his presentment made by his Ma^{ty} Grand Jury and to a Bids judgment
 that then his Perogizant to be void, otherwise to remain in force
 and to be levied on his goods in Court.
