 his side, he seemingly going to light his pipe, took up a great brand and of fire, and went to his wife a full
 upon his wife, whereupon he left to him, and took it from him, and he drove her out of doors to night &c.

Warrant. Smeeth Cundy Jr. For as much as Mary the wife of Thomas Riggan some of the
 County Labourer hath required a writ of Habeas Corpus for the said Thomas Riggan her husband & will have taken her
 personal care before us that she required the same, not for any private malice hatred or evil will, but simply
 & is afraid of her life, or the hurting or maiming of her body or any other such thing as well as for her
 or the like occasion he refusing to put in good securities for his part, as now he still doth as well for her
 appearance before our Justices for the said County at the next Court to be holden the second Tuesday in November
 next ensuing and also that the said Thomas shall in the mean time keep the said Mary as well towards the said
 towards all their other people, and especially towards the said Mary all ways coming no ways to comply
 it but wilfully refuse &c.

And so are therefore in their Majesty's Names. So the Sheriff of Somerset County aforesaid to require
 you, and also strictly charge and command that immediately you take the said Thomas Riggan into your custody
 and him safely keep until he shall willingly do the same and that if you do not do so you will
 answer the contrary &c. Given under my hand and seal this eleventh day of October 1690 in
 the second year of their Majesty's reign &c.

 justly indebted to their Majesty the several and respective sums of money therein mentioned to wit Thomas
 Riggan some the just sum of twenty pounds sterling money of England, and Edward Riggan Junior the
 sum of twenty pounds of like sterling money, and Edward Dutton the sum of twenty pounds of like
 sterling money due to be levied on the goods and chattels & tenements of the said Thomas Riggan some
 Thomas Riggan Junior & Edward Dutton or their Heirs, Executors or assigns as witness their hands and
 seals this day and year above said

The condition of this recognizance is such that if the within bounden Thomas Riggan Junr shall personally appear before
 their Majesty's Justices of the Peace at the next Court to be holden the first day of the County to answer to the matters as shall
 be objected against him by Mary his wife with in named to do and show that he is the said Court shall be then there
 enjoined him, and that in the mean time, he do keep the said Mary as well towards the said Mary as all their other people
 and especially towards the said Mary his wife, that the said Court to be kept of peace for other ways to stand in
 in full force power & virtue.
