

This Indenture made the two and twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord
 God according to the computation of the Church of England one thousand six hundred
 eighty and nine Between Sampson Baker of New England Mariner of the one part
 and John Parkynson of the Bridge town in Barbadoes Merchant on the other part witnesseth
 that whereas Sampson Baker party to these presents did lately for and in consideration of
 the summe of one hundred pounds of good & lawfull money of England paid purchase
 Capt Isaac Hopkyns of Chiswick in the County of Northampton in Eng^r land & Bridge
 his wife severall tracts or parcels of land to the quantite of one thousand seaven hundred
 & fiftie acres more or less as by the severall patents with more plaine appear whiche
 tracts or parcels of land are situate lying and being in the County of Somerset in the
 Province of Maryland here after called or knowne by the name of Hantock Butts and
 bounded as by the said patents remaining upon record in the Land office at St. Maries
 and the conveyance made betwene the said Capt Isaac Hopkyns & Bridget his wife
 on the one part and Sampson Baker party to these presents on the other part bearing
 date the 20th day of March 1660 acknowledged as heviled according to law & remaining
 upon record in my office in Som^r set County in the Province of Maryland aforesaid defining
 more plaine and at large appear relacon being therunto had to have and to hold
 the aforesaid tracts or parcels of land to him the said Sampson Baker his heirs & assignes
 for ever & the reversion & revertens remainder & remainders thereof together with all houses
 edifices buildings yards orchards gardens & privileges there unto belonging or in any way
 appertaining AND also the said Capt Isaac Hopkyns & Bridget his wife above named in
 the above mentioned conveyance for the consideration of the hundred pounds above
 specified bargaine sell make over & deliver unto the said Sampson Baker all theire stocke
 Cattle and hoggs with theyre lead or could make any rightfull claime to running & being in the
 County of Somerset in the Province of Maryland aforesaid marked with their proper marks with
 right ear bopt & underbitted the left ear flitt & underbitted and all horses & mares running in the
 County as well branched as unbranched to w^t they the said Capt Isaac Hopkyns & Bridget his
 or either could or may lay any just claime unto to have & to hold the said cattle hoggs horse
 mares to him the said Sampson Baker his executors & assignes with their future increase for ever
 as by the said Deed remayning upon record ab aforesaid will more plaine and at large appear
 AND this Indenture further witnesseth that the said Sampson Baker for and in consideration of the
 summe of fiftie five pounds of good and lawfull money of England to him in hand paid at
 before the sealing & delivery hereof by the said John Parkynson party to these presents the receipt where
 he deth herby acknowledge and himselfe therewith fully satisfied contented and paid & of every part
 & parcel thereof do by these presents acquit & discharge him the said John Parkynson his heirs executors
 & administrators as also for divers other good causes & consideracions him the said Sampson Baker having
 mowing hath given graunted bargained sold ~~and delivered~~ assigned and sett over and by these presents
 doth give graunt bargaine sell assigne & sett over unto him the said John Parkynson the full moneye value
 of the aforesaid purchased tract or parcels of land containing one thousand seaven hundred & fiftie acres
 more or lesse with the moyses or halfe of all houses edifices buildings yards orchards gardens backydards
 premises there unto belonging and every part & parcel thereof with all & singular the appurtenances
 ab also the full moyses or halfe of all such hoggs cattle horses and mares w^t are running on the said
 or in the said County of Somerset aforesaid unto w^t the said Sampson Baker for any waies lay an
 claime unto by vertue of the Deed above mentioned made to him the said Sampson Baker by
 Isaac Hopkyns and Bridget his wife the which said land & stock more is in his custody possession of
 the said Sampson Baker or his assignes dide the reversion & reversiones remainder & remain
 rents & yearly profits whatsoever of all & singular the said premises & every part & parcel
 with all appurtenances to have and to hold the said moyses or halfe of the said
 seaven hundred & fiftie acres of land with all houses w^t the same
 & backydards
