appeared in Court Sarah Ward Servant Woman to John King being presented by the Grand Jury to Tuesday in March for Blasphemous Scarey, and King duly examined by the Court openly confessed at t. and sayeth that Joseph Cottor is his father of her Blasphemous Child. for which offence the said Rumbelby doth his Majesties Service corporall punishment and that a fine may be taken was granted by the Court, she giving security for forty days work and dyst when demanded by as also for her good behaviour and Court charges, and that she should appear next Court there to the Joseph Cottor. And therupon came John King and by Recognizance did King before the Court, for the said Sarah's performance as above.

17. Oct. County. H. The Jurors for their Majesties Service upon the Holy Evangelists at a Grand Jury held for the Body of this County the second Tuesday in November last past do present and find that Katherine Tully Woman Servant to Walter Lewis of this County hath most wilfully Sinfully and shamefully committed fornication and at one birth borne two Blasphemous Children being the second Offence. to the great dishonour of Almighty God, great scandall and evil example of their Majesties good people and against the Laws and Institutions of this Province their Majesties Attorney General judgment may be awarded against the said offender according to Law in that Case made and provided. com. James Saenger Ch. Ind.

Searched Indictment being read before the Prisoner at the Barr, who pleads not guilty to the Ind. but she is married to one Bryan Kelly about three months agoe. and the said Bryan then appearing & the same, as also to be the father of those two Children (which Children) was adjudged to be six months old. And for which said offence the Court Ordered them to pay thirty days work and dyst, but want of Security, the Court then Ordered them thirty lashes a piece to be well on their bare backs, which by the said Sheriff was executed.

17. Oct. County. H. The Jurors for their Majesties Service upon the Holy Evangelists at a Grand Jury held for the Body of this County the second Tuesday of November last past do present and find Daniel M. Glasham, and Jane Lee both of this County, upon the oaths before their Majesties Proclaiming any fear of God before their eyes, but most wilfully shamefully and Sinfully with base Discountenance and Renowne sin of Adultery upon the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to the great dishonour of Almighty God, abuse of whose Body the scandall and evil example good people of this Province and against the Laws and Institutions thereof. their Majesties Attorney General judgment against the said Daniel and Jane according to Law. Ch. Ind.

This foregoing Indictment being read before the Prisoners at the Barr, both pleads not guilty of the Ind. Only Mr. Glasham confesses to be drunk for which he was ordered to be fined according to Act of Assembly. No Substantial Evidence appearing, the Court Ordered both the said Daniel and Jane to give Security for good behaviour during pleasure, and Court Charges.

Bryson rans (Capt. John Windham), and did acknowledge him self to be in Debts unto their Majesties personal sum of One thousand Sterling money to be levied on his goods and chattels.

The condition of which Recognizance is set that if the said Daniel be of good behaviour and abstain from all their Majesties people of this Province, then he shall acknowledge and Recognize to be bound afterwards to be and remain in full power force and credit, and the said Daniel was likewise bound in five hundred pounds as above.

June rans Thomas Lee and William Perry and obliged them selfes as above for James Lee's behaviour and Court Charges.
