The Jurors for their Ma^{ties} being sworn upon the holy Evangelists at a Grand Jury hold for the body of this County the second Tuesday in November last past doe present and find that John: Strifoll of this County did upon the month of July last past wickedly and feloniously steal and carry away a Rope belonging to Henry Heyman of this County Planter of his herse of the value of One hundred pounds of Tobacco and within the Jurisdiction of this Court contrary to the sacred and divine Lawes of Almighty God and wholesome Lawes and Constitutions of this Province and against the publick peace, therefore their Ma^{ties} Attorney Generall judgment may be entered against the said Strifoll according to Law in that Case made and provided. James Sangster C. Jnd.

John Strifoll appeared and pleaded not guilty to the Indictment. His severall Circumstances being considered. it was then Ordered that the said Strifoll pay Henry Heyman five dayes work and Court Charges.
