wreighty affair, whiche shall be acknowledged as an act of favour to a straneger and so will

Now all men by these presents that I Henry Suite of the County of somerset and Province of
N. E. doth confess and appoint my loving friend Mr. Joseph Chapman my true and lawfull attorney
for me and to my use to ass demand and receive all manner of debts dues or demands that is any way
due unto me in the Government of New England, by Bill, Bond, curte or otherwise and upon refus
or non payment to sue arrest impound or imprison any person or persons that is any wayes in
detention, and upon occasion to employ our attorney or me as to shall think convenient and
necessary, and upon payment of any debt or debts to give release and discharge as aforesaid
as if I were there personally present ratifying and confirming what my said attorney shall law-
fully doe in all things as I may or ought to doe as witness my hand and seal this 14. Feby 1689
