Articles of Agreement that the day of November Anno 1609 between Ambrose London  
gentleman in dwelling in the Province of New England in the County of Somersett of the one party  
Joseph Mason Cooper of the same County above named Whereas sometime Joseph Mason  
had bought a tract of Land of the said London & kept it three years in his hands and that  
London being performed Joseph Mason had agreed with London to pay him the rent  
of the Land and London to sale his Land again and give Joseph Taylor for security to pay London  
his rent and to Land alighted to London again as it was before Joseph Mason had  
any thing to do with it as witness o Land & Sealts

Whereas Joseph Mason formerly did buy to pieces of Land of Major Ambrose London the  
one parcel sold by the name of Felice the other sold by the name of Black ridge the  
Land lying in the point of Land that devideth an acre or more in the  
land or lands that was first inhabited by the said London for the last payment for  
this Land w<sup>t</sup> 1600 thousand pounds of good sound marchandise tumbars in aforesaid  
without ground leane or tylt paid at some convenient place in Massachusetts mentioned  
or Poldomark to be paid at three thousand payments the first thousand to be paid in the  
year one thousand six hundred ethty to the second thousand to be paid in the year 1603  
the third and the last thousand to be paid in the year 1604 and for the true performance  
of these free payments of three thousand pounds of tumbars for this Land above  
mentioneds this tumbars is to be paid at or upon the tenth day of November of each  
year above mentiond whereas formerly Joseph Mason had given security for the  
payment of this tumbars above mentiond and his security the  
to be release his have release his security and bound over his land the same to  
pieces of land above mentiond which he bought of the aforesaid London and this  
is the condition of handing over of this Land to Major Ambrose London his heirs  
executors administrators or assigns by me Joseph Mason that if I doe not pay or cause  
to be paid this tumbars above mentiond during year according to the time  
and performance of the first pay payment which will be as above mentioned or other of  
the other to shall be absolute for it upon those to pieces of Land above mentioned and  
Joseph Mason do bind myself my carres executors administrators or assigns to deliver  
up the patent that have in my custody and all my rights and title that have in that  
Land above mentioned to Major Ambrose London his heirs executors administrators  
or assigns for ever perpetually for ever to enjoy as thair one proper land as witness my hand  
& seal this 13<sup>th</sup> day of June 1609
