behaviour to all their Ma<sup>ties</sup> Lige peop<sup>l</sup> of this province and that he pay Court Charges  
that then this Estrogizance to be void otherwise to remain in full power force and virtue.

And whereas the sd Emanuel stands indicted in that he hath most wilfully sinfully  
and shamefully committed fornication with An. Buller a woman servant to Sam<sup>l</sup>  
Horsy and upon her body hath begotten a Bastard Child to the great dishonour of  
Almighty God, scandall and evil example to all the good peop<sup>l</sup> of this Province  
and agt the good Laws and Justitutions of this Province and agt the good laws  
and Justitutions therof. Their Ma<sup>ties</sup> Attorney Generall judgment may be entered agt  
the sd Myro according to law in that Case made and provided. or?

The said Emanuel pleads not guilty to Just.  
But the sd An Buller at y<sup>e</sup> Barr makes Oath that the sd Emanuel Myro is the  
only father of the said Bastard Child. For where said fact he being of full age though he  
guilty. is by the Court ORDERED that the Sheriff take into Custody the said Myro
