pleads not guilty and for tryall put himselfe upon the
County. viz the Jury.

Latham of this County plauter, hath most wickedly, sinfully and shamefully committed
that heinous and abominable sin of adultery, justifiably by the diabol did seduce
and allure, Violta: Warren, wife of Richard: Warren from of the high way into the
woods near the Bridge by Buntingham and there leapt and caused her to Violta to
prostitute her body to her lust and unchastity, thereby dishonouring God, giving scandal
and evill example to the good people of this County therefore the Ma^{ties} Attorney reads
judgment. may be ordered agt the said Offender according to Law.

behaviour. and thereupon came John: Franklyn and William: Round, and by recogni-
tance bound in 5. a peere, Latham in 10. shillings — The Condition of the
recognizance is such, that if the said George Latham be of his good behaviour and
abstaine to all their Ma^{ties} Liege people of this County, that then this recognizance
to be void and of none effect otherwise to be and remain in full power force &
