at Littleton within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted to the said William the sum of Thirteen
Bushells of good sound merchantable tobacco, being for divers goods & merchandise before that time
sold and delivered as by a particular account howe of howe in Court ready to be produced more fully
and at large appearte, and the same John to the sd William in manner aforesd being indebted, the same
John in Consideration thereof did assurme upon him selfe and to the sd William then and there faire
fully promiseth that he to John the said Trowton Bushells of what he to the sd William when required
to be delivered would well and truly deliver and pay therewithal the sum he to John due
promiseth and assumption as not regarding but misusing and fraud viously intencioning the said sum
in this behalfe craftily and subtilly to deliv're and defraud Trowton Bushells part of the same that
Bushells of what he to the sd William Rate not paid, although the sd John to do the same by the said
William afterwards was requested but hath hitherto refus'd and doth still refuseth to the damage
to the damage of the sd William of 800^l of tobacco and therof to bringe his suit

the sum of One thousand pounds of tobacco, being the Gallants of aee. due to him those deliv'd for one
part to the sd William sold and delivered, and the sd William to the sd Sheldward in manner and being
indebted did assurme upon him selfe and to the sd Sheldward faithfully promiseth the sum of one thousand
pounds of tobacco when required would deliver and pay therewithal the sd William the sum of 1000^l
of tobacco to the sd Sheldward hath not paid to the damage of the sd Sheldward of 1600^l of tobacco and therof
